## **Directions to property**

### **From Dunedoo**

- Head toward Dubbo on the Golden Highway.
- About 10 km out you will go over the Tucklan Creek Bridge
- About 200-300 meters past this on the left hand side there will be two mailboxes - turn LEFT
- Follow signs to "Oakfield"
- If you get to the Cobbora turnoff you have gone too far.

### **From Dubbo**

- Head toward Dunedoo on the Golden Highway
- About 70-80km out you will pass the Cobbora turnoff on the left hand side of the road
- Continue for 2-3 km
- After 2-3 km past the Cobbora turnoff you will see two mailboxes on your right – turn RIGHT
- Follow signs to "Oakfield"
- If you get to the Tucklan Creek Bridge you have gone too far.
